

A statement can be something that you want to say




A statement can be something that you write down

We have the right to take risks




We have the right to be a part of our community the way we want to be

We should **not** be judged




We should **not** have unfair costs

We have the right to be respected




Our staff will always work with us

We will be well trained so we can make good decisions for our future






Statement 5


