People supported and staff in Milton Keynes have completed a sponsored 10-mile cycling challenge for Milton Keynes Hospital's Learning Disability Team, raising over £1,000.

After the issues of Covid in 2020 and the number of people in hospital getting higher our service and the people we support wanted to make a difference.



Julie, a Senior Practitioner at MacIntyre said:

"We really felt for the people going into hospital alone, without being with their loved ones. We talk about this and Paul and Steve, who we support, said they would like to do something to help to bring them some comfort."

Julie then said "We wanted to raise money and help the learning disability team at the Milton Keynes Hospital.

What started as a group walking exercise within the people we support bubble group, quickly turned into group bike rides, a strong suit for both Paul and Steve's skills.




## My Favourite place By Michael in Bedfordshire

## **Baked mushrooms and festive cheese**



To make baked mushrooms and festive cheese you will need



 500 grams of large flat mushrooms



• 125 grams of spinach



• 1 tablespoon of Nutmeg



 180 grams of wensleydale cranberry cheese









• Cranberry sauce



Salad



Pan



Knife



Baking tray



Colander







Put the oven on at 170c or gas mark 3



Cut out the stalks of the mushrooms



Put the mushrooms on the baking tray cup side up



Fill your pan with water and heat until the water is boiling



Add your spinach to the pan for 2 minutes



Then drain the spinach







Mix together the spinach and one table spoon of nutmeg




Put some spinach onto each mushroom



Break the cheese on top of the spinach and mushrooms



Add half a tablespoon of cranberry sauce on top of each mushroom



Put them in the oven for 15 minutes



Put the mushrooms on a plate with some salad And enjoy







## **Christmas Main Festive Puff Pizza**



To make festive puff pizzas you will need



Baking tray



Christmas tree cookie cutter



• 1 tablespoon of cream cheese
This needs to be a big scoop



1 tablespoon of pesto
 This needs to be a big scoop









• 3 cherry tomatoes



Fresh basil



• 100g of grated cheese



 1 sheet of ready made puff pastry



Put the oven on at 180c or gas mark 4



Carefully unroll the pastry sheet







Cut 3 tree shapes out of the pastry



Put the tree shapes on a baking tray



Use a fork to prick the trees



Mix together the cream cheese and the pesto



Spread the mixture on the trees








Cut each tomato into three slices then put three slices on each tree



Put some basil on top



Sprinkle with cheese



Put into the oven for 15 to 20 minutes

• 300 gram tin of mandarins




1 pack of orange jelly








#### **Social distancing**
