



Our use of website cookies

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site. Cookies may be used for:

- remembering choices, settings and preferences you made, so you do not have to keep re-entering them (functionality cookies).
- remembering terms of use you have accepted so you do not need to keep accepting them (strictly necessary cookies). Without these cookies, information you are looking for cannot be provided.
- measuring how you use the website so we can make sure it meets your needs (performance cookies).

Note that most web browsers allow you to modify your preferences to notify you when a cookie is set, or to reject all cookies. However rejecting them will mean that certain areas of a website will not function correctly.

Most web browsers allow some control of most cookies through the browser settings. To find out more about cookies, including how to see what cookies have been set and how to manage and delete them, visit <http://www.allaboutcookies.org>

MacIntyre website cookie control

MacIntyre allows cookie control on our website through a panel which differentiates 3 types of cookies:

1. **Necessary cookies** - these enable core functionality such as security, network management, and accessibility. You may disable these by changing your browser settings, but this may affect how the website functions.
2. **Functional cookies** - These cookies allow our website to remember choices you make to give you better functionality and personal features.



3. **Performance cookies** - These cookies collect information about how visitors use our website, for instance how visitors arrive on our site, which pages they visit most often, and if they get error messages from web pages. These cookies don't collect information that identifies a visitor. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. It is only used to improve how our website works.

These are the cookies that are created on a user's browser when visiting MacIntyre's website (www.macintyrecharity.org):

Cookie	Category	Use
PHPSESSID	Necessary	Allows the website to deliver logged in sessions for users with logins
ComplianceCookieMAC	Necessary	Allows the website to remember users' Cookie choice
__atssc __atuvc __atuv	Functional	Allows us to use AddThis, a widget allowing users to share website content to social media platforms
_ga _gat_gtag _gid	Performance	Collects statistical data for Google Analytics
_hjAbsoluteSessionInProgress _hjSessionUser _hjSession _hjTLDDTest _hjid _hjIncludedInPageviewSample	Performance	Used by Hotjar to collect data such as how many times a web site has been visited by different visitors, if a visitor has visited the website before or if it is a new visitor, statistical data on users' behaviour on the web site
